Shastri/Graduation with Sanskrit/Post Graduation in Sanskrit from recognized University with at least 50% marks either in Shastri or in Graduation or in Post Graduation and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) from National Council for Teacher Education recognized institution.

OR

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4-year Bachelor in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) with Sanskrit.

OR

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4-year B.A./B.Sc.Ed. with Sanskrit or B.A.Ed./B.Sc.Ed. with Sanskrit.

OR

Graduation with Sanskrit at least 50% marks and 1-year B.Ed. (Special Education)

OR

Post-Graduation in Sanskrit with minimum 55% marks or equivalent grade and three-year integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed.

a) BA/B.Com/Post Graduate from recognized University with at least 50% marks either in Graduation or in Post Graduation and 1 year Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.). ✓

OR

BA/B.Com/Post Graduate from recognized University with at least 50% marks either in Graduation or in Post Graduation and 2 Years Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.). ✓

OR

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 year Bachelor in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.). ✓

OR

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 year B.A.Ed. ✓

OR

B.A/B.Com with at least 50% marks and 1-year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed.) (Special Education).

OR

**3. TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHER (MEDICAL):-**

a) B.Sc. (Medical)/Post Graduate from recognized University with at least 50% marks either in Graduation or in Post graduation and 1 year Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.)

OR  
 B.Sc. (Medical)/Post Graduate from recognized University with at least 50% marks either in Graduation or in Post graduation and 2 Years Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.)

OR  
 Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 year Bachelor in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.)

OR  
 Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 year B.Sc (Medical).Ed.

OR  
 B.Sc. (Medical) with at least 50% marks and 1-year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed.) (Special Education)

OR  
 B.Sc. (Medical)/Post Graduate from recognized University with at least 50% marks in either Graduation or Post Graduation (or its equivalent) and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) from NCTE recognized institution.

OR

Note(2):- A candidate shall be eligible for appointment to Class-III post(s), if he/she has passed Matriculation and 10+2 from any School/Institution situated within Himachal Pradesh. Provided this condition shall not apply to Bonafide Himachalis.  
 Note(3):- Relaxation upto 5% will be allowed in minimum educational qualifications and also in minimum qualifying marks for TET to the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/PH categories of H.P.

**Essential Qualification** as per R&P Rules read with the NCTE notifications issued from time to time till date:-

10+2 with 50% or Senior Secondary with 50% marks from a recognized board of School Education and 2 years Junior Basic Teachers Course / Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) from an institute affiliated to Himachal Pradesh Board of School Education (HPBOSE). ✓

OR

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-years Junior Basic Teacher (JBT) / Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) (by whatever name known). ✓

OR

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 45% marks and 2 years Junior Basic Teacher (JBT)/Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) (by whatever name known), in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2002. ✓

OR

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 years Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) ✓

OR

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and two year Diploma in Education (Special). ✓

OR

Graduation and 2 years Junior Basic Teacher (JBT) / Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) (by whatever name known). ✓

OR

Post-Graduation with a minimum 55% marks or equivalent grade and three-year integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed." ✓
