1.2 About: EKLAVYA MODEL RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL SELECTION TEST -2026:

This Common Entrance Test is being conducted to fill 150 seats in Class VI on a merit basis in various schools established in the State of Himachal Pradesh under the Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) Scheme. EMRS is a Central Sector Scheme aimed at providing quality education to Scheduled Tribe (ST) students from Class VI to XII, particularly in remote areas, to enable them to access the best educational opportunities and to bring them at par with the general population. However, children belonging to all other categories who have lost their parents due to LWE/insurgency/COVID-19, children of widows, children of Divyang (Persons with Disabilities) parents, land donor children, orphan children, etc., shall also be eligible to appear in the examination, subject to fulfilment of the prescribed eligibility conditions and applicable as per norms.

In pursuance of the above and for the purpose of facilitating the selection process, the Himachal Pradesh Board of School Education (HPBoSE) is hereby expressly authorized to conduct the Screening Test on behalf of the Tribal Development Department, Government of Himachal Pradesh, through the H.P. Eklavya Residential School Management Society, Shimla-1. The conduct of the said test shall be strictly governed by the instructions, guidelines, directions, and policy decisions issued by the Government or EMRS Himachal Pradesh from time to time. The counselling and admission process shall be conducted by the H.P. EMRS Management Society. It is further clarified that the recommendations of HPBoSE shall not confer any vested right of admission, which shall remain subject to final verification and approval by the EMRS Management Society.

2. IMPORTANT INFORMATION AT A GLANCE:

(a) Please read the Information Bulletin of Eklavya Model Residential School Selection Test-2026 (EMRSST-2026) carefully before filling the Online Application Form.

(b) Candidate can apply only ONLINE for Eklavya Model Residential School Selection Test-2026 through website <www.hpbose.org>

(c) The application for ONLINE for Eklavya Model Residential School Selection Test-2026 (EMRSST-2026) has been made completely online with the facility to upload Bio data, photograph, and signature detail of the applicant. The applicants are hereby advised to keep the scanned images of photograph and signatures ready in JPG format before applying online.

(d) All Candidates must ensure that the information (like his/her name, mother's name, father's name, gender, date of birth, mobile number, e-mail address, photograph and signature, choice of cities for exam Centre, etc.) provided by them in their online Application Form is correct and of their own. Candidates are advised to exercise the utmost care in filling up correct details in the Online Application Form. Any request for change in the particulars and uploaded scanned images at any stage will not be considered by HPBOSE once the correction

period is over under any circumstances. HPBOSE will not entertain the corrections sent by the candidate through Post/Fax/WhatsApp/E-mail/by Hand.

(e) The applicant must have to submit his /her valid and active E-mail ID and Mobile Number while filling of Application Form, so that Board may use electronic mode of communication while contacting him/her at different stages of examination process.

(f) The candidate should satisfy his/her eligibility before applying and shall be personally responsible in case if he/she is not found eligible as per the given eligibility criteria at any stage. In case it is found at any time in the future that the Candidate has /uploaded the photograph and signature of someone else in his/ her Application Form/Admit Card or he/she has tampered with his/her Admit Card/result, it would be treated as Unfair Means (UFM) Practices on his/her part and the actions will be taken under the provisions of Unfair Means Practices, as detailed in the Information Bulletin.

(g) The applicants are strongly advised to apply online well in time without waiting for the last date of submission of online application. Application Forms received through fax/post shall not be entertained and Board does not take responsibility to inform such candidates.

(h) Multiple Application Forms submitted by a candidate will not be accepted at any cost.

(i) The final submission of the Online Application Form will remain incomplete if all the steps are not complete. Such forms will stand rejected and no correspondence on this account will be entertained.

(j) The candidates are not required to send hard copy of confirmation page to the HP Board of School Education Dharamshala. However, it is advised to retain the hard copy of the application/confirmation page with himself / herself for future reference.

(k) Candidates are NOT allowed to carry Instruments, Geometry or Pencil box, Handbag, Purse, any kind of Paper/ Stationery/ Textual material (printed or written material), Eatables and Water (loose or packed), Mobile Phone/ Earphone/ Microphone/ Pager, Calculator, Docu.Pen, Slide Rules, Log Tables, Camera, Tape Recorder, Electronic Watches with facilities of calculator, any metallic item or electronic gadgets/ devices in the Examination Hall/Room.

(l) Candidates shall appear at their own cost at the Examination Centre on the date, shift, and time indicated on their Admit Cards issued by the HPBoSE in due course through its Website.

(m) Candidates are advised to visit the HPBoSE Website and check their e-mails regularly for the latest updates.

6. **MODE AND METHOD OF ONLINE APPLICATION**

1.	Visit official website of HPBoSE i.e. www.hpbose.org ; click on “CET / Vacancy” Option and then select EMRSST – 2026 link for filing the online application. a) After successful submission of data/ detail an Application number will be automatically generated. Candidates should keep Application Number for future references. b) If application number forgotten then click on “Forget Application No.” and application number can be retrieved. c) Upload valid detail, photo, signatures and submit declaration. d) For Online activity access and to download Admit Card use “Application Number” as ID and Date of Birth as password. e) Candidate should keep a Print of confirmation Page with him/her.
2.	Before applying candidates are advised to go through the detail instructions PROSPECTUS available on the website (www.hpbose.org) of the Board carefully.
3.	Before applying candidates must ensure that the all detail they have filled on the online application are correct. Select, category, sub-category etc. carefully.
4.	Mobiles including earphones and connected cords and other electronic gadgets are banned within the premises of the examination centers. - 3 **Date of Birth:** Enter/Select Date, Month and Year of birth as per the English calendar and as recorded in Birth Certificate. For example, if born on 3rd May 2015, the date should be entered as follows 03-05-2015.
- 4 **Gender:**
Select the appropriate option Male/Female/Transgender.
- 5 **Aadhaar Number / Card.**
Enter the 12 digit Aadhaar no.
- 6 **Reservation category**

7.4 STEP 4 – Print Out of Confirmation Page

1 Declaration:

The candidates will be asked to check the particulars entered before final submission. The candidates are required to tick the declaration before final submission otherwise system will not allow to proceed further.

2. Print of Confirmation Page:

Candidates are required to take printout of confirmation page for record and keep it for future reference. The detail filled by candidate during the online submission shall be final and shall not be changed under any circumstances.

8. Correction/Updation in Details:

The candidate's particulars cannot be changed/edited once the registration form has been submitted. Thereafter corrections in the particulars can be made online w.e.f. 16-02-2026 to 18-02-2026 **Till (11:59 Pm)** only by the candidate himself and no further request for change in particulars will be entertained under any circumstances. The Board will not be responsible for any consequences arising out of non-acceptance of any correction/addition/deletion in any particular once filled in the Application Form for whatsoever reasons.

The candidates shall be permitted to make on-line correction in their following particulars Candidate name, Father name, Mother Name, date of birth, Candidate Photo, Signature, Contact Number, Email Id, Gender, Eligibility, Nationality, Correspondence Address, Permanent Address, Pin-code, Distt., Choice of Examination Center Subdivision.

No change will be accepted through offline mode i.e. through fax/application or by email etc. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained. Please note that no request for any change in particular will be accepted under any circumstances after the specified date for online correction is over.

9.1. Eligibility:

a) ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATIONS :

1. Candidates appearing/ appeared for Class-V exams in Govt. / Govt. aided/ Govt. recognized School/CBSE Affiliated School /Level B of NIOSOBE Programmed to December 2025 / March 2026 or who passed in 2025-26 are eligible.
2. Candidate who has not attended any school but studied at home is also eligible to apply for admission in Class VI (As per section 4 of Chapter II of RTE Act 2009). However, the parents/guardian of the candidate shall have to submit a self-declaration regarding the same. The format is available at FORM 27.2 Actual admission in Class-VI for the session 2026-27 will be based on the merit of the Selection Test provided that above mentioned conditions are fulfilled by the candidates.
3. Candidate should not be rusticated from any of the schools.
4. Appearing candidates of class 5th Exam in till March 2026 shall also be eligible for EMRSST-2026. However, such candidates will be eligible for counseling if they pass the class 5th class exam in the session 2025-26 (winter vacation Schools).
5. Candidate belonging to the reservation categories mentioned at table 9.4.I in respect of Himachal Pradesh are eligible to apply for admission.

b) AGE Limit:

The minimum and maximum age limit (as on 31st March of the year in which admission is sought) for admission in Eklavya Model Residential Schools in various classes is given below: (Child born on 1st April will also be considered.)

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9.3 General Eligibility Criteria:

The candidates belonging to the reservation categories mentioned at table 9.4, In respect of their domiciled State/UT are eligible to apply for admission.

A candidate should fulfill the age criteria as mentioned at point 9.1 Admission Eligibility. In case of doubtful cases of overage in comparison to the age recorded in the certificate, they may be referred to the District Medical Board for confirmation of the age. The decision of the Medical Board for confirmation of the age. The decision of the Medical Board will be treated as final and binding on both the parties.

Candidate should not be rusticated from any of the schools.

9.4. Reservations in Admission:

In accordance with EMRS Guidelines November 2020 & MoTA letter No. F. No.

11011 /02 /2019 – EMRS / PVTG dated 30.03.2021, the below mentioned reservation criteria shall be followed for granting admissions in Class VI:

Note: 5% i.e. 3 seats out of 60 are reserved for differently abled children. These seats shall be carved out @ 2 seats from ST and 2 seat from others.

- The number of seats for boys and girls will be equal.
- Transgender category students shall not be denied admission subject to fulfillment of eligibility conditions. Transgender category to be considered under Boys' category at time of admission
- For point No. iv of Reservation Table above, the proposed consolidated quota of reservation is 10% and no individual quota is allocated to any category mentioned therein. The HP EMRS Management Society may to decide upon the percentage and priority of individual quota of the categories mentioned there in depending upon local situations & circumstances.

5. If a child belongs to more than one reservation category, then he/ she shall be allowed to avail the benefit of only one reservation category with the highest reservation percentage.
6. The merit list for each category shall be prepared separately on the basis of the EMRSST-2026 (i.e. merit of Boys & Girls separately and reservation category mentioned in (i) & (iv) above). The cutoff marks shall be different for different reservation categories

10. Admission Selection Procedure:

10.1 Admission for Class VI

Admission to class VI shall be made strictly on the basis of an entrance test called Eklavya Model Residential School Selection Test (EMRSST). The candidates desirous to get admission in EMRSs have to appear and qualify EMRSST.

10.2 Procedure to register for EMRS Selection Test (EMRSST)

- (i) The candidates belonging to the reservation categories mentioned at Reservation Table 2.4 (1) of a State are eligible to apply for EMRSST.
- (ii) Registration forms can be filled through the online/ offline mode.
- (iv) The list of Exam centers for EMRSST are also to be displayed at the websites/ web-portal.
- (v) In all EMRSs, a help desk shall be made available to assist the candidates/parents to fill online/ offline registration form free of cost.
- (vi) Verification of proofs for residence, age, eligibility etc. shall be done for selected candidates by the EMRSs where the child shall be admitted after the declaration of results & provisional list of selected candidates by State/ UT EMRS Societies

10.3. Issue of Admit Cards

The admit cards will be displayed on websites/ web portal of the HPBOSE. EMRSs running under the State/ UT may also be given the responsibility of issuing the Admit cards (online/offline registration) to the candidates appearing for EMRSST. As far as possible, the Exam center nearest to the residence of the candidate be allotted.

10.4. Result of the EMRSST

The result of EMRSST shall be announced on HPBOSE website/ web portal. The result will also be displayed on the websites of Ministry of Tribal Affairs., National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS). EMRSs running in the State. Nodal Principal/ Officer of the State.

Also, the Principal, EMRS concerned, will inform the selected candidates about the result through SMS on the registered mobile number followed by an intimation through speed post.

- 10.5. A provisional admission list (and waiting list(s), if required), based on EMRSST shall be released by the State/UT EMRS Societies. The admission in EMRS, however, shall be granted to provisionally selected candidates on production & verification of required documents by the concerned EMRS. Candidates are advised to apply for TC/ SLC from parent school only after the verification of documents and confirmation of admission by the respective EMRS.
- 10.6. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Secretary/ Principal Secretary, Tribal Welfare Department/ Chairman, State/UT EMRS Society shall be final and binding on the candidates.
- 10.7. The candidates and their parents/guardians may note that the children will be admitted strictly as per the Merit list prepared on the basis of EMRSST and in the allotted EMRS only. The candidate has to furnish five preferences for admission in respect of the EMRSs running in their State. Under no circumstances, the selected candidate will be given admission to any other EMRS. No request for shifting of students on account of residence in a particular district, medium of instruction in the EMRS concerned, shifting of parents/guardians to other districts / States etc. will be entertained. If a candidate, on the basis of the merit list, is eligible for admission in the EMRS other than five preferential EMRSs, then he/ she shall be granted admission in that EMRS in accordance with his/her position in the Merit List.
- 10.8. Counseling Sessions need to be conducted while allocating seat in the EMRS to the student based on his/ her preferences and position in the merit list prepared on the basis of EMRSST.
- 10.9. It is expected that the seats should be open to all ST children of the State with no specific reservation quota for the ST resident of block/ taluka/tehsil/district in which EMRS is situated. Notwithstanding, the State/ UT EMRS Societies may exercise their privilege to fix specific quota,

not exceeding 30%, for the ST candidates belonging to block/ taluka/ tehsil/ district in which the EMRS is situated.

It is clarified that the candidates belonging to the reservation categories as mentioned in the table 2.4 (i) (I to iv) across the State are eligible to apply for admission in any of EMRS irrespective of the fact that whether an EMRS is running in their block/taluka/tehsil/district of residence or not.

10.10. Incomplete application forms shall normally be rejected. In case, vacancies remain, State/ UT EMRS Societies may allow completion of the form later at their discretion.

10.11. Admission secured on the basis of any wrong certificate shall be cancelled by the Principal EMRS Societies may allow completion of the form later at their discretion. Forthwith and no appeal against such action of the Principal shall be considered.

11 Composition of the Test:

The EMRSST, conducted in offline mode, may be of two-hour duration with 100 objective type questions from 3 sections for a total of 100 marks. The medium of instruction for the Examination may be English/ Hindi/ Regional Language or bilingual.

A single test booklet comprising of all the three sections will be given to each candidate. There shall be no syllabus for EMRSST. The Question Paper of EMRSST will be based on Competencies in accordance with the Level prescribed for Class V students by NCERT/ SCERT/ CBSE. Additional time of 30 minutes will be allowed for "Divyang students" (differently-abled students).

However, it is expected that dedicated concerted efforts are put in wide publicity, Information of the EMRS Scheme & Admission Process and necessary support have been extended to the desirous students.

Special drives, if required, for filling up of vacant seats in existing EMRS Society needs to be conducted.

12-Documentation:

The candidates who are provisionally selected for admission will have to submit the requisite documents, as demanded by the EMRS, at the time of admission for verification. The State/ UT EMRS Societies shall have to inform the candidates at the time of Registration & display of list of provisionally selected Candidates about the documents required for Admission,

However, a list of suggestive documents is mentioned as below: -

- Date of birth certificate issued by the authority competent to register births. This will include certificates from Notified Area Council/Municipality/Municipal Corporation extract about the date of birth from records of Village Panchayat, Military Hospital and service records of Defense personnel or Affidavit. The original certificate of date of birth should be returned to the parent after verification. Admissions up to class-VIII may be granted without any school transfer certificate provided the child is otherwise eligible and his birth certificate has been issued by a Govt. body or affidavit.
- Aadhaar Number / Card.
(It is pertinent to mention here that none of the child is to be denied admission on non-submission of Aadhar number. For the students with no Aadhar Number, the concerned EMRS where the child shall seek admission shall facilitate him/ her in procurement of Aadhar Number).
- Domicile! Reservation Category certificate.

- iv. Service Certificate of the parents in case of Children of Staff of EMRS/ EMOBS/ CES/ Doctors/ Paramedical staff of Government Hospital serving in the same block.
- v. Disability Certificate, if applicable.
- vi. Report Card of the preceding class/ an Affidavit in case of the children who have not attended any school but studied at home.
- vii. Report of Medical Checkup of the Provisionally Selected Students is to be carried out by the EMRS.
- viii. Transfer Certificate/ School Leaving Certificate from the previous School. But, at the time of Registration the child is required to submit Bonafide Certificate from the school currently attending or self-declaration in case of not attending any school but studying at home/ NIOS Registration or Passing Certificate.
- ix. Any other documents required. (As decided by State EMRS Society)

13. Timeline for Admission in EMRSS

Time line for admission will be declared by the EMRS as per the top merit list of EMRSST-2026.

Note: -

List of children registration, Question Paper & Answer Key after conduct of test, Result of EMRSST & EMRSLT, list of provisional selected children, waiting list and subsequent lists to be compulsorily displayed on the websites of the State/UT EMRS Societies and concerned EMRSS, in addition to display on Schools Notice Board.

If any of the dates happens to be a public holiday the next working day shall be treated as opening\closing dates.

14. Validity and Applicability:

The Validity Period of EMRS Test-2026 will be for admission to class 6th in the Eklavya Model Residential Schools for the session of 2026-27 in various Schools in the State of Himachal Pradesh.

- 14.1 **Legal Status:** In case of any dispute, the decision of the Secretary/ Principal Secretary, Tribal Development Department/ President, HP EMRS Management Society shall be final and binding on the candidates. The record of EMRSST, after declaration of EMRSST result, shall have to be preserved for six months. And in case of legal implications, the record of EMRSST shall be preserved for one year further after the disposal of litigation. Litigations regarding conduct of EMRSST-2026 shall be dealt by the HP EMRS Management Society whereas; NESTS shall deal with the Litigations regarding Admission Guidelines at New Delhi.

15. EXAMINATION CENTRES FOR EMRSST-2026 (District wise):

Note 1: Examination Centre shall be in compatibility with the number of application received and preferably at District Headquarter Level. In case the number of candidates in any District/Subdivision Headquarter is very less for running the examination in that District/Subdivision Headquarter then the candidates of that District may be allotted Examination Centers in nearby District/Subdivision Headquarter. The H.P. Board of School Education reserves all the rights to allot/change or cancel any examination center at its discretion. The examination center once allotted to the candidate shall not be changed. No online or offline request for change of examination center shall be entertained at any stage.

16. LANGUAGE OF QUESTION PAPER

The question booklet will be set and supplied in bilingual i.e. both in English and Hindi.

18. USE OF CALCULATING DEVICES/ PHONES/ WRITTEN/ TEXTUAL MATERIAL: -

Use of Calculators, Watches with Facilities of Calculator and Cellular Phones is strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall. Candidates are also strictly forbidden from carrying any Textual Material printed or written, bits of paper, envelope or any other material into the Examination Hall except the Admit Card.

18.1 Candidates are advised to carry only the following with them into the examination venue:

- i. Admit card along with Self Declaration (Undertaking) if any downloaded from the HPBOSE Website (a clear printout on A4 size paper) duly filled in.
- ii Aadhar Card
- iii. A simple transparent Blue/Black Ball Point Pen.

- Application form which is not submitted online or incomplete shall not be considered and no Admit card shall be issued to such candidates.
- Admit Card Can be download from the Board's Website www.hpbose.org 4 days before the exam. The admit cards shall not be dispatched by post/fax or sent by E-mail.

- c) Report of subject expert shall be considered final and will be incorporated for Final Answer Key and shall be published as " Final Answer Key " on the official website for public interest in information.
- d) The result shall be prepared as per final answer key and no objections regarding Final answer key shall be entertained.

(ii) A fully computerized system has been adopted for the evaluation of the answer scripts optical mark reader (OMR) for the preparation of the results. Since the evaluation will be error free under the above system, there is no provision for revaluation or rechecking of the answer scripts or recounting of the marks scored. The result of EMRSST-2026 will be available on Board's Website <www.hpbose.org>.

21. **WEEDING OUT RULES**

The records of EMRSST-2026 including OMR Response Sheet are preserved up to six months from the date of declaration of result in the accordance with EMRS Weeding Out Rules.

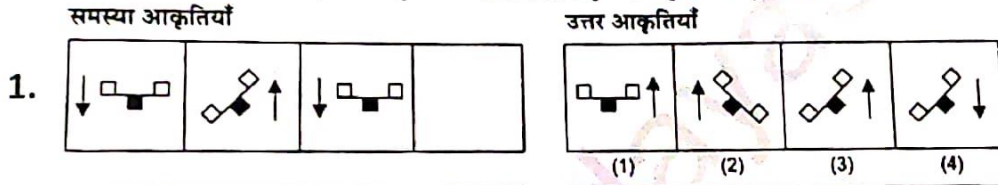

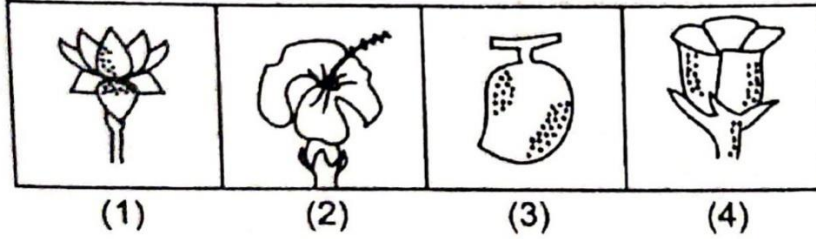

- a) Being in possession of any item or article which has been prohibited or can be used for unfair practices including any stationery item, communication device, accessories, eatable items, ornaments, or any other material or information relevant or not relevant to the examination in the paper concerned;
- b) Using someone to write examination (impersonation) or preparing material for copying;
- c) Breaching examination rules or any direction issued by HPBoSE in connection with Aforesaid examination;

- d) Assisting other candidates to engage in malpractices, giving or receiving assistance of any kind directly or indirectly or attempting to do so;
- e) Contacting or communicating or trying to do so with any person, other than the Examination Staff, during the examination time in the Examination Centre;
- f) Threatening any of the officials connected with the conduct of the examination or threatening any of the candidates;
- g) Using or attempting to use any other undesirable method or means in connection with the examination;
- h) Manipulation and fabrication of online documents viz. Admit Card, Score Card, Self-Declaration, etc.;
- i) Forceful entry in /exit from Examination Centre/Hall;
- j) Use or attempted use of any electronic device after entering the Examination Centre;
- k) Affixing/uploading of wrong/morphed photographs/ signatures on the Application Form/Admit Card;
- l) Creating obstacles in smooth and fair conduct of the examination.
- m) Any other malpractices declared as Unfair Means by the HPBoSE.

26.2. Punishment for using unfair means practices: During the course of, before, or after the examination if a candidate indulges in any of the above or similar practices, he/she shall be deemed to have used unfair practices and booked under UNFAIR MEANS (U.F.M.) case.

27: MISCELLANEOUS

1. Correspondence with HPBoSE and EMRS / TD

All the correspondence should preferably be addressed by e-mail. The email query shall be addressed only if it is not anonymous and contains the name, postal address, and contact number of the sender. An email containing vague or general queries and other queries as contained in the Information Bulletin / Prospectus shall not be entertained. Queries shall not be entertained from a person claiming to be representatives, associates, or officiates of the applicant candidate.

The following information shall not be revealed by phone or email:

- a) Internal documentation/status.
- b) The internal decision-making process of HPBOSE Any claim/counterclaim thereof.
- c) Dates and venue of internal meetings or name of the staff/officers dealing with it.
- d) Any information which cannot be revealed in the opinion of HPBOSE / EMRS.

28 PROCEDURE FOR COUNSELLING WITH EMRS.

- a. Counselling Sessions(s) shall be conducted by the HPEMRS Management Society while allocating seats in the EMRS to the student based on his/ her preferences and position in the merit list prepared on the basis of EMRSST-2026
- b. The candidates/parents are advised to remain in touch regularly with the Tribal Development Department website for updates at web address <https://himachalservices.nic.in/tribal/en-in/emrs.html>.
- c. After declaration of Result of EMRSST-2026, candidates, who fulfill the required eligibility criteria as mentioned in Para 2.3 above, along with all relevant documents will be eligible for appearing in the counselling process.
- d. All the meritorious candidates are necessarily required to appear in the Counseling Sessions to ensure their admission; otherwise seat will be allocated to the next candidate.
- e. The date/time/venue for counselling round shall be decided by the Society and intimated through web portal. No separate letter for any round of counselling will be sent to any candidate. No letter, FAX or telephonic enquiry about the admission will be entertained.
- f. The candidates who are provisionally selected for admission at time of counselling, will have to submit the required documents, as demanded by the Society at the time of counselling /admission.
